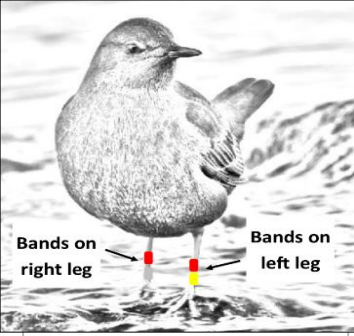


Citizen Science Dipper Watch Form
